PE and Sports Funding –2017/18

Vision

Funding for the 2017/2018 academic year is expected to be over £16,000 for Primary PE and Sport. We are committed to ensure that this funding is used to support extension of our current provision and to build sustainable development in training, partnerships and developing PE and Sports through initiatives and resources. Through Physical Education all pupils will become physical literate along with knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for life of learning, leading a healthy lifestyle through physical activity.

Impact

To ensure all pupils participate in fun, purposeful physical activities in a safe learning environment. All pupils will be challenged through balance, coordination and physical movement activities whilst developing the link between their physical, cognitive, social and emotional learning. This framework will safeguard a smooth transition through each Key Stage and enhance their achievement both on and off the field of play.

This will be achieved through:

- The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick-starting healthy active lifestyles
- The profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
- Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- Increased participation in competitive sport
- Positive role models

The award will be used to;

- Maintain and develop our current provision delivered by PE specialist, out sourced agency
- Enhance training for staff to develop sustainability; Across the PE curriculum
- Increase our current provision to develop high impact activities to support our aims to improve our levels of activity in our children.
- To development a personalised and diverse PE curriculum for all pupils
- To develop our extracurricular programmes- procuring additional resources and brokering high quality coaches, including gymnastics.
- Promote and improve health and wellbeing within Rainbird with more active playtimes and investing heavily in a purpose built trim-trail.
